

OUT OF JURISDICTION RESPONSES: CY 2011

The rows of this chart indicate which fire department or agency responded and the columns are the cities they responded into. The numbers represent how many DISPATCHES occurred, not necessarily how many completed responses there were. Often, a unit will be dispatched to assist with an emergency in another city but one of the local units becomes available while they're enroute to the incident so Verdugo cancels the "visiting" unit and the "home" unit proceeds with the response.
